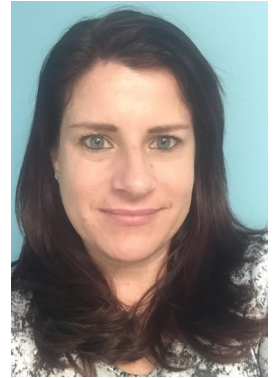


Welcome Our New Psychiatrist, Elisha Greggo, M.D.

Dr. Elisha Greggo spent 4 years as the program director for the inpatient child psychiatry unit at William S. Hall Psychiatric Institute in Columbia, SC. There she served as the treatment team leader for patients 12 and under admitted to the state psychiatric facility for crisis stabilization. There she developed a new behavioral modification program, utilizing a positive reinforcement model for children in the child inpatient unit. In addition to her clinical responsibilities; she also served as an associate clinical professor at the University of South Carolina School of Medicine. She was honored in 2015 with the Chairman's Award for Outstanding Contribution to Medical Student Education. She completed her clinical training at the Medical University of South Carolina in Charleston, SC and SUNY Upstate Medical University in Syracuse, NY.
